This firm represents McMullen Valley Water Conservation & Drainage District, an Arizona irrigation district that receives Hoover power from Western Area Power Administration (Western) through the Arizona Power Authority, and uses that power to serve irrigation water pumping and related agricultural loads in rural Arizona. We are writing to express our serious concerns about Secretary Chu's March 26, 2012 Memorandum to the PMAs, and particularly its implications for Western.
