

Re: Defining the Future – 90-Day Extension Request


The Arizona Municipal Power Users' Association (AMPUA) is an association of consumer-owned and operated electrical systems and it consists of cities and towns, rural electric distribution and generation cooperatives, special districts, irrigation and electrical districts, and Indian utilities. Collectively the members deliver almost one-half the electricity in Arizona to over a million people and its members have participated in the processes organized and overseen by the JOT since its creation by Secretary Steven Chu concerning changes to the federal Power Marketing Administrations.

AMPUA understands that the next step in this process will be issuance of a Federal Register notice containing recommendations from the JOT Team and soliciting comment.

Due to the potentially broad and technical nature of these recommendations, AMPUA requests a 90-day period to comment, which would allow for sufficient examination members of these recommendations by our PMA customer members. Furthermore, this time period will allow the JOT to analyze all comments and incorporate them into its final recommendations. AMPUA requests the final recommendations be made public at the conclusion of this process.
