The Rice Solar Energy Project involves the proposed construction of a 150-MW solar-powered generating facility in Riverside County approximately 15 miles west of Vidal Junction, California. The facility would be located on approximately 1,500 acres of private land and would include a new 10-mile long transmission line across BLM-managed land to interconnect with Western's electrical transmission system. Western/BLM intend to prepare an EIS to analyze the impacts of their respective proposed Federal actions.
